The Network has provided 270 law enforcement trainings in the last ten years.

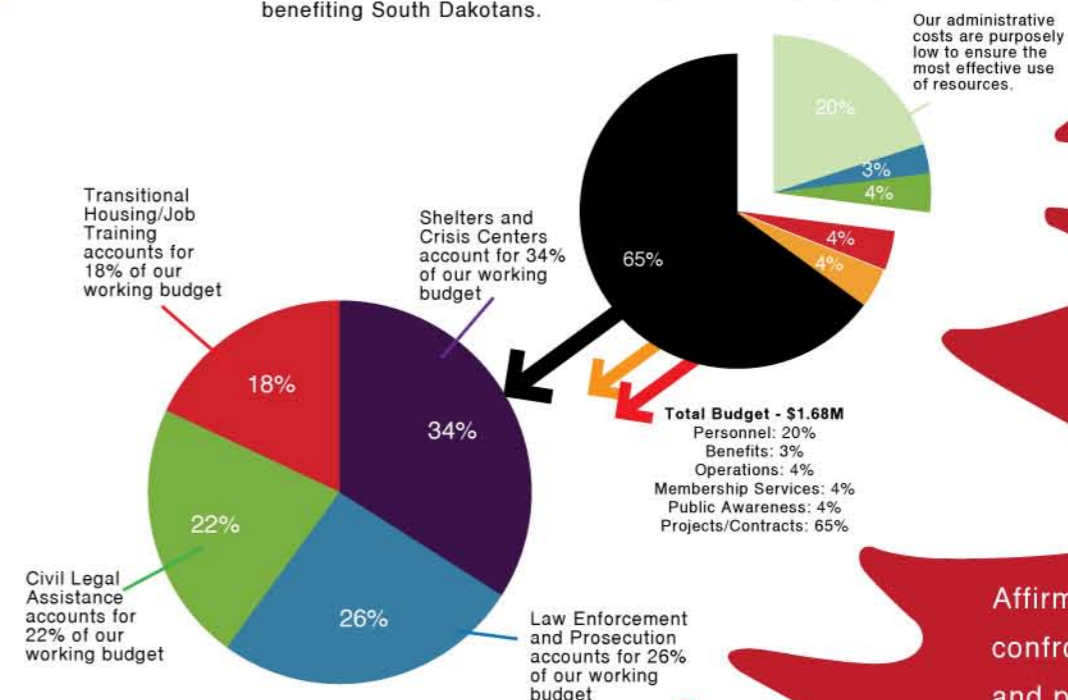
did you know?

Rural victim advocates funded by the Network have traveled over 680,000 miles providing services for victims and their families since 2002.

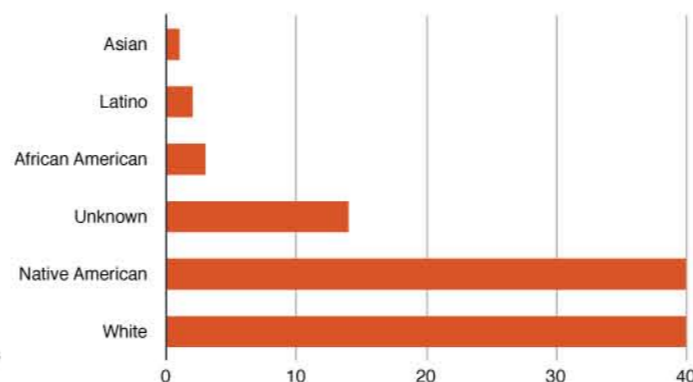
20 years of financial responsibility
