Civil Legal Services for clyears or younger who sexual assault:

- **Privacy issues** Such as release privileged and/or confidential mental health, medical or education records; work with schools to protect victim privacy where possible.
- **Safety** Protection orders, working with schools and employers to enforce safety measures.
- Education Help victims obtain assistance/services from school such as course/schedule modification, leave of absences, and disciplinary hearings.
- •Victims' rights Protection from the accused, the right to proceed freely from unreasonable delays, to be treated with fairness and respect for victims' privacy and dignity.

Additional family services for nonoffending parent:

- Family Law Representing nonoffending parent of victims in divorce, child custody, and guardianship proceedings.
- **Housing** Negotiate with landlords for accommodations such as breaking a lease or increase safety measures.
