
SOUTH DAKOTA SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM SURVEY

CURRENT ACTIVITIES OF SARTS/CCRTS



Teams are participating in a variety of activities, including:

Case Consultation (49%); Case Review (69%); Protocol Development (56%); Data Tracking (41%); Community Education (77%); Community Awareness Opportunities (77%); Sexual Assault Response (85%); Domestic Violence Response (62%); Human Trafficking Response (39%); Stalking Response (15%); Surveying (8%); and Evaluation (18%).

75% are currently working and holding regular meetings.
