October 19, 2021 10am CT/9 am MT Identifying Indicators of Labor Trafficking Webinar—As the lesser known half of the human trafficking equation, few people are aware of the indicators of labor trafficking and, as a result, survivors of labor trafficking often go unrecognized. With the goal of helping providers better understand the dynamics of labor trafficking and the many different forms in which labor trafficking can manifest, we will examine several labor trafficking case studies across different industries. Particular attention will be given to the unique vulnerabilities of immigrant communities and how labor traffickers exploit people on the basis of their immigration status (or lack thereof).
